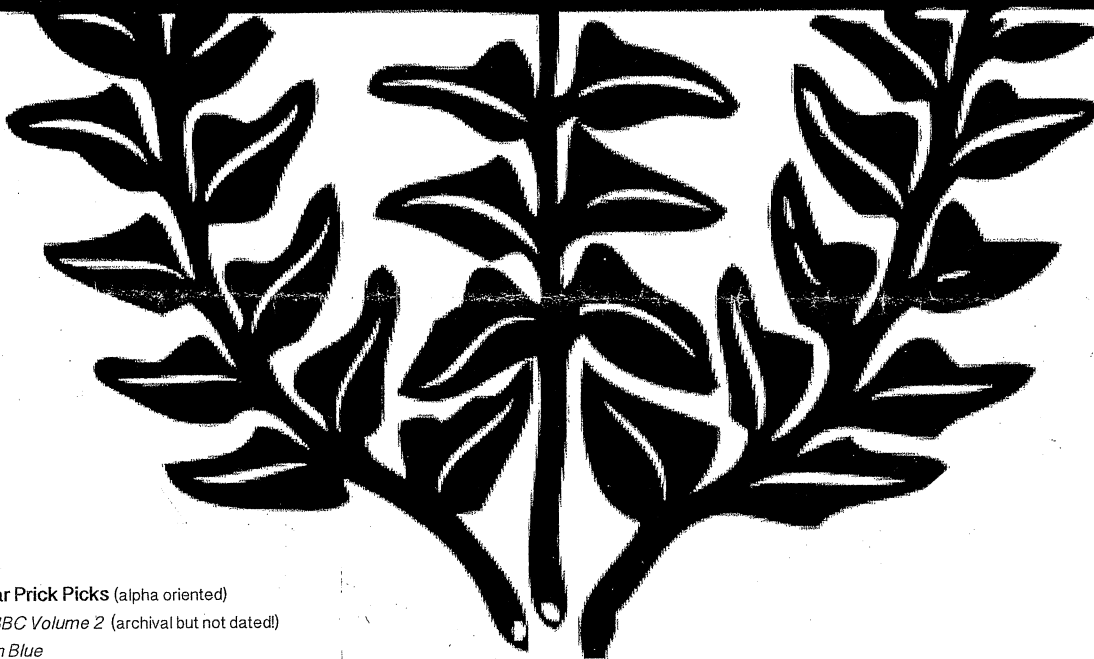

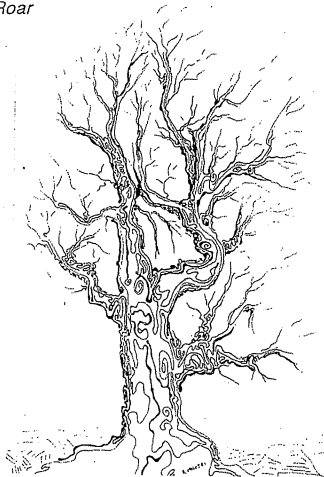

- 1) Jessica Lea Mayfield - "*Make My Head Sing*" - Different sound for Mayfield this time around. Influenced by Nirvana in a good way.
 - 2) Drive-By Truckers - "*English Oceans*" - First record with the new line-up featuring Matt Patton, bassist from the amazing Dexateens. Mike Cooley steps up with his biggest contribution yet, penning 6 of the 13 songs
 - 3) Johnny Cash - "*Out Among The Sky*" - These recordings come from lost 1980s sessions with famed country-politan producer Billy Sherrill which were shelved by Cash's record company, Columbia and discovered by Cash's son John Carter Cash in 2012.
 - 4) King Tuff - "*Black Moon Spell*" - Thanks to Amy Crawford, Rich Whitaker, and Hutch Quintella for turning me on to this great Vermont band.
 - 5) Jack White - "*Lazaretto*" - When White performed these songs on Austin City Limits, he had two bands, one made up of men and one made up of women. Super performances all around, especially from drummer Carla Azar.
 - 6) John Coltrane - "*Offering: Live At Temple University*" - Recorded less than a year before his death, this rare recording shows Trane still growing and exploring.
 - 7) Various Artists - "*While No One Was Looking Toasting 20 Years Of Bloodshot Records*" - Some of my favorite all time records come from these folks. Happy anniversary!
